

Train-the-Trainer Program & Certification 2019 Adaptive Sports USA National Conference November 12 & 13, Phoenix, AZ

ASAP is a 5-session, 7.5-hour, sexual abuse prevention training program for staff and volunteers of adaptive sports organizations. Through interactive exercises and analysis of news stories, participants learn to:

- Recognize sexual abuse
- Interrupt unsafe or inappropriate interactions that could escalate to abuse
- Think critically and productively about safe and appropriate interactions
- Report sexual abuse and collaborate with a local rape crisis center

The goal of preventing sexual abuse is clear, but the reality of how to achieve it is far more complex. ASAP will give you the skills to facilitate critical conversations and develop needed skills to help ensure that every athlete in your program is safe.

This **16-hour certification program** will qualify you to teach the ASAP curriculum in your organization and to other adaptive sports programs in your area. After successful completion of the 2-day train-the trainer program, you'll have access to copyrighted curriculum materials, technical assistance, and an evaluation survey that was developed by an outside research organization. The requirement for recertification is **an annual 90-minute webinar**.
